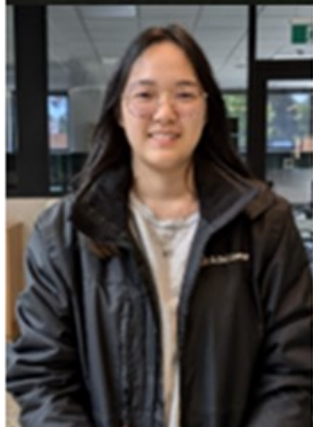
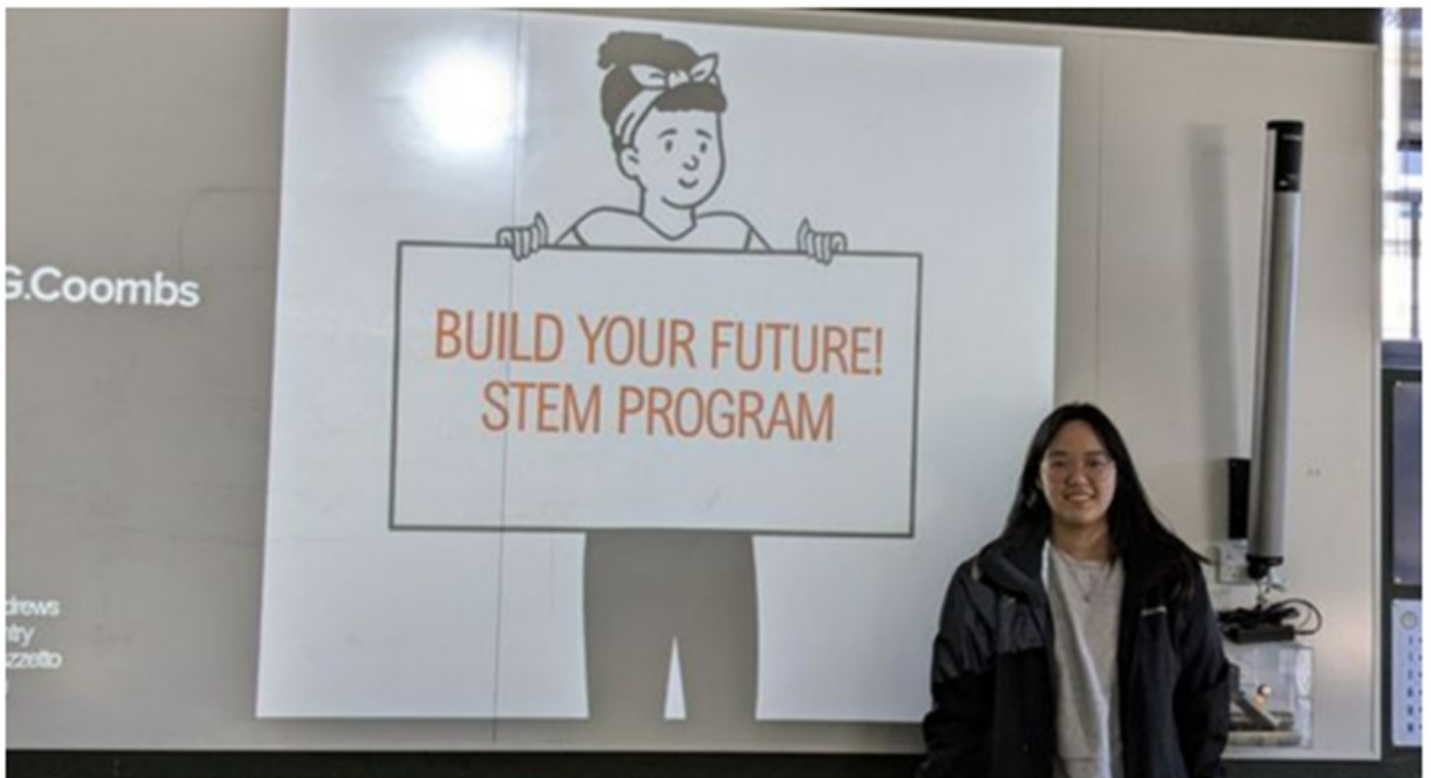

We were thrilled to welcome back alumna Helena Ly-Lu, during October, to speak with our Year 9 and 10 students about the many pathways in STEM, including engineering, fire engineering, drafting, electrical, and mechanical disciplines. Helena graduated with a Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering from RMIT University in 2022. During her studies, she contributed to notable projects like the First Nations Medical Clinic in Frankston, to the Southgate Fire Mode operation, and the City of Melbourne car park upgrade. Helena began her graduate program with A.G. Coombs in August 2023. A.G. Coombs is the leading Australian provider of specialist building services. Their expertise is in air conditioning and mechanical services, fire protection, hydraulics, electrical services, and lighting, and building control technologies. Together with her colleagues is she pioneering a school-based initiative to promote STEM careers for women.
